Since 1998 I have lived in Paris and met various musicians. I lived with music and created my pieces there. I'm very grateful that many musicians around the world have performed my pieces with their sympathy for my music.

In 2018, after 20 years in Paris, I moved to a small village called Puget in the Luberon (in Southern France Provence) for my new step in my life.

Here, the beautiful light shines down, the pleasant wind that blows down under the clear blue sky sounds pine needles, and at night the full starry sky where the flow of the galaxy can be seen spreads. When the season comes, the flowers of red poppy and Lavender bloom, and each day is blessed by nature with fruits, vegetables and herbs. The Luberon is full of the energy of nature and the joy of life.

Through my life here, I have come to want to share and transmit the joy of music in this surroundings. Now I can deeply understand why Sviatoslav Richter chose The Luberon for the place of the now-famous “Festival International de Piano de la Roque d'Anthéron”. I built a music salon in our home for sharing the music. I named here “La Mélodieuse”.

At this “La Mélodieuse”, a new type of class has started since the summer of 2020. Regardless of amateur, professional, age, performance level, or instrumentation, I would like to meet a variety of people who loves the music here.

Last summer, 2022, two flutists who I can call my old friends, pianists who I can trust their music and lovely students who came from all over the world, I spent precious time with them. It remains as a lights overflowing memory for me. Also, I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to the people of our Puget village who warmly supported this event and to all the audience who gathered for the concerts.

In 2023, we will continue to hold two classes with them, wonderful flutists Carol Wincenc (Professor of Juilliard School) and Michel Moragues (Soliste of l'Orchestre National de France, Professor of Chamber Music at C.N.S.M. de Paris).

Well, once again, a bright summer is on its way back to the Luberon. I hope that the musical gathering we started will continue for a long time here in Puget Village.

* Repertoires

This masterclass aims to give you a deeper understanding of music.

Both **Flute repertoire** and **Yuko Uébayashi's flute works**, please select the music you want to learn the most and register it as your **first choice in the repertoire**.

If there is a music you want to learn as the second music, you can register up to your second choice.

If the repertoire could not be narrowed down at the time of application, you can register as undecided. Also, if you have any questions about the repertoire or any matters you would like to discuss, please write them down.

In any case, each flute professor or Yuko Uébayashi will consult about the repertoire.

* Appearance in two concerts

All student can perform in two concerts.

♪ **Musique pour tous** ♪ is an enjoyable stage to play with all musiciens (professors, students, pianist, harpist, violinist, cellist,,). In session 1, the concert will be held in the foyer of the school in Puget village, and in session 2, it will be held in the courtyard of «Château La Verrerie», a winery representing the Luberon

«**Final concert of Masterclass**» All students can perform about 10 minutes in this concert. People who truly love the music of the village will gather at the salon of «La Mélodieuse». It is the moment when the music you play is wrapped in the warm cheers of the people.

* Attendance Fee : 1200euros

-Class fee 960euros

Individual lesson by flute professor 3 times X 1 hour

Individual lesson by Yuko Uébayashi 3 times X 1 hour

Include attendance of audit for all classes (48 hours) and concerts.

-Meal bill 240euros per person

7 Dinners (arrival date + 6 days of class), 6 Lunches (6 days of class)

Lunch is a buffet and Dinner is a seated dinner. All participants and professor will surround the table together.

* Capacity of each session : 8 people

The reception will be closed for 8 people.

I would like to value the motivation of the participants. So I do not judge the performance in advance.

♪ About accompanist

A pianist accompanies all lessons in the Masterclass and your performance in the Final Concert. This is very important for learning music as a total work, or for knowing the joy of chamber music.

As accompanists, pianists who are deeply trusted by Yuko Kambayashi will participate. They all have great musical expression as soloists. They are also experts in the theory and technique of advanced accompaniment and chamber music, one of the traditions of French music.

If you already have a co-star, we welcome you to join us with your co-star.

If the repertoire you play requires a cello accompaniment, during Session 1, we can assign a cello accompaniment for you.

***Accompaniment fee 250euros**

Includes accompaniment for all classes attended and attendees' concert.

If you wish, you can rehearse with an accompaniment for 25euros per hour.
